(iv) That the proposed fees relevant to those licences and licensing activities where the authority has the discretion to determine the fees, as set out in Appendix 3 and Appendix 4, be implemented on the 1 April 2021; (v) That the proposed fees relevant to Animal Welfare licensing, as set out in Appendix 5, be implemented on the 1 April 2021; (vi) That Officers be instructed to include the fees in 2021/22 annual fees and charges report that is presented to full Council; (vii) That the proposed fees relevant to hackney carriage, private hire and operator licensing, as set out in Appendix 6, be implemented on the 1 April 2021; (viii) That Officers be instructed to include the proposed fees, as set out in Appendix 6, in the 2021/2022 annual fees and charges report that is presented to full Council.
