**Request:**

Yesterday, 14<sup>th</sup> April 2025, we received copies of a booklet regarding the forthcoming election for the Combined Authority/Mayor.

Please can you advise how this document was funded?

I.E. Was it funded by the Combined Authority; Other tax-payer funded authority; The candidates who have their 'address' in the rear; or a combination of more than one?

If any of the funding was provided by other than the candidates who have their 'addresses' in the document, please provide a breakdown of how much this document cost to produce and deliver.

**Response:**

The Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority fund the printing and distribution of the booklets, with £500 contributions from each candidate towards the cost of printing the booklets.

Quoted price for production of the booklets - £54,652.32

Quoted price for postage of the booklets – £462,960.00
